REGULAR MEETING

Welcome and Pledge of Allegiance

Sandra McKee welcomed members of the taskforce, Megan Warren led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes from August 18, 2020 Meeting approved

Megan Warren motioned to approve minutes, Jay Reiss seconded the motion

Election of Chairman, Vice-Chairman, and Secretary

Megan Warren made a motion to elect Dan Morris as Chairman, Ben Warren as Vice-Chairman, and Megan Warren as Secretary. Jen VanMeer seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Discussion Regarding Recent Planning and Zoning Issues

>Sandra McKee having a meeting with Karen and Pam Lakey, representatives for Weiser River Trail. Will discuss the possibility of putting a restroom near the trail and fairgrounds

Discussion regarding painting a mural on the side of the Museum. It is decided the Mayor and Sandra McKee will approach members of the museum board with the idea. May invite them all to next Taskforce meeting.

>Megan to discuss ideas for murals with Chris Braun, other local artists

Ben Warren leads discussion on Hunter's Inn. Owner has expressed interest in donating property to the City or Commercial Club. Property is in foreclosure.

>Ben Warren to speak with Rhonda VanOrder who has significant banking knowledge regarding Cancellation of Debt and foreclosure issues, gather information for the Taskforce to decide if we should proceed with this undertaking.


Set Next Meeting Date and Time
