Special Meeting
April 2, 2018
7:00 p.m.***

A special meeting of the Cambridge City Council was held on April 2, 2018 at Cambridge City Hall. The purpose of this special meeting was to hold a workshop on amending Title 5, Chapter 3 (Dogs) and Chapter 4 (Animals) of the Cambridge city code.

Present were Mayor Jack Toothman, Council President Mark Loveland, Jeff Chance, Gary Franklin, and Verl Cate. Also present was City Clerk/Treasurer Sandra McKee, Ernie Houghton Public Works Superintendent, Nadine Chance, Richard Trost, and Thel Pearson.

Mayor Toothman called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m. and explained that the purpose of this special meeting was to have a workshop on Amending Title 5, Chapter 3 (Dogs) and Chapter 4 (Animals).
